

Liminka

Liminka is a Finnish municipality in the province of Northern Ostrobothnia. The municipality is home to 10,253 people and it is the youngest municipality in Europe. 40% of the population is under the age of 18 and the average age of the population is 31 years.

Liminka's cultural services support and develop the community's cultural activities and events. Cultural work is carried out in co-operation with organizations, communities, cultural operators, schools and educational institutions in the region.

Liminka's youth services work with young people aged 7-29. Youth work is preventive educational work carried out as a multidisciplinary collaboration with various actors. Youth Services provides children and young people with safe operating environments in which they have the opportunity to engage in voluntary or supervised leisure activities.
