August 7 - November 3, 2023


Tyrnävä, Finland

In this project two (2) volunteers work with young people in the municipality of Tyrnävä in the North Ostrobothnia region. The municipality has a population of 6 700, and approx. 40% of them are under twenty years old. Tyrnävä is know for vast fields as far as the eye can see.



Volunteers participate in the local youth work: joining youth clubs, youth workshops etc. They work together with local youth to create activities and increase involvement. Volunteers are also planning and organising events for and with local residents e.g. in the culture sector and library.





## Accommodation, food and transportation arrangements

Volunteers are accommodated in an apartment. Volunteers need to cook for themselves (food allowance and pocket money will be provided). Within the municipality the distances are short: main venues are mainly reachable by foot. If needed, other transportation is provided.

Mandatory costs are covered according to programme rules.

## Training

The volunteers participate in an on-arrival training organized by the Finnish National agency. The volunteers can also get Finnish language lessons if they want.

Volunteers are guided to all tasks. The volunteer's personal skills or interests are considered and discussed before the project and an individual work plan is made for all volunteers.

## Volunteer profile

We would like to host active volunteers who are motivated to work with children and young people. Working hours change according to tasks, so volunteers need to be flexible. As the tasks include working with children, an extract of the criminal records is required.

Volunteers must be prepared to live in a rural environment
